Noah's Sons in their Moral Environment

7:1 And the <b>LORD said unto Noah, Come thou and all thy house into the ark</b> ; for thee have I seen righteous before me in this generation. 2 <b>Of every clean beast thou shalt take to thee</b> by sevens, the male and his female: and of beasts that [are] not clean by two, the male and his female. 3 Of fowls also of the air by sevens, the male and the female; <b>to keep seed alive upon the face of all the earth.</b> ...	8:15 And <b>God spake unto Noah</b> , saying, 16 <b>Go forth of the ark, thou, and thy wife, and thy sons, and thy sons' wives with thee.</b> 17 <b>Bring forth with thee every living thing that [is] with thee</b> , of all flesh, [both] of fowl, and of cattle, and of every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth; <b>that they may breed abundantly in the earth, and be fruitful, and multiply upon the earth.</b>

Actions by the Waters	
7:17 And the flood was <b>forty days</b> upon the earth; and <b>the waters increased</b> , and <b>bare up the ark, and it was lift up</b> above the earth. 18 And <b>the waters prevailed</b> , and were increased greatly upon the earth; and <b>the ark went</b> upon the face of the waters.	8:6a And it came to pass at the end of <b>forty days</b> , ...

God Remembered Noah	
8:1a And God remembered Noah, and every living thing, and all the cattle that [was] with him in the ark:
