


## Warning concerning the Faithful and Merciful High Priest: 3:7-4:13

Note alternation of "disobedience" and "unbelief"

Heb. 3:18 And to whom sware he that they should not enter into his rest, but to them that believed not  $\dot{\alpha}\pi\epsilon\iota\theta\dot{\epsilon}\omega$  **G544** [were disobedient]? 19 So we see that they could not enter in because of **unbelief**  $\dot{\alpha}\pi\iota\sigma\tau\iota\alpha$  **G570**.

Num 14:11 And the LORD said unto Moses, How long will this people provoke me? and how long will it be ere they **believe** me, for all the signs which I have shewed among them?

Num. 14:43 For the Amalekites and the Canaanites are there before you, and ye shall fall by the sword: because ye are turned away from the LORD [**disobeying** him LXX], therefore the LORD will not be with you.

John 3:36 He that **believeth**  $\pi_{1}\sigma_{1}\varepsilon\dot{\omega}\omega$  on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not  $\dot{\alpha}\pi\epsilon_{1}\theta\dot{\epsilon}\omega$  [disobeyeth] the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him. Heb. 3:12 Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of **unbelief**  $\dot{\alpha}\pi i\sigma\tau i\alpha$ , in departing from the living God.

Builds on "faithful" πιστός G4103 Heb 3:1-6

Heb. 4:11 Let us labour therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of **unbelief ἀπείθεια** 

[disobedience].


Perhaps anticipates "merciful," e.g., Heb. 5:8 Though he were a Son, yet learned he **obedience** by the things which he suffered;

## The Person of our Lord in Hebrews 1


Comparison of Hebrews 1 to Hebrews 2-10
