
Bearing Iniquity (53:11, 12)

- **The sinner** (often): Lev 5:17 And if a soul sin, and commit any of these things which are forbidden to be done by the commandments of the LORD; though he wist *it* not, yet is he guilty, and shall **bear his iniquity**.
- The sacrifice: Lev 16:22 And the goat shall bear upon him all their iniquities unto a land not inhabited: and he shall let go the goat in the wilderness.
- **The Priest:** Exo 28:36-38 And thou shalt make a plate *of* pure gold, and grave upon it, *like* the engravings of a signet, HOLINESS TO THE LORD. ... 38 And it shall be upon Aaron's forehead, that Aaron may **bear the iniquity** of the holy things, which the children of Israel shall hallow in all their holy gifts;
 - Num 18:1 And the LORD said unto Aaron, Thou and thy sons and thy father's house with thee shall **bear the iniquity** of the sanctuary: and thou and thy sons with thee shall **bear the iniquity** of your priesthood.
- **The Lord** (often): Exo 34:6-7 And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth, 7 Keeping mercy for thousands, **forgiving iniquity** and transgression and sin, Micah 7:18 Who *is* a God like unto thee, that **pardoneth iniquity**, and passeth by the transgression of the remnant of his heritage? he retaineth not his anger for ever, because he delighteth *in* mercy.


