Accusation

Judgment and Justice in Isaiah

God desires them:

5:7 For the vineyard of the LORD of hosts *is* the house of Israel, and the men of Judah his pleasant plant: and he looked for **judgment** משׁפט, but behold oppression; for **righteousness**, but behold a cry.

He commands his people to pursue them:

56:1 Thus saith the LORD, Keep ye **judgment משׁפט**, and do **justice צדקה**: for my salvation *is* near to come, and my righteousness to be revealed.

The nation claims to do them:

58:2 Yet they seek me daily, and delight to know my ways, as [if they were] a nation that did **righteousness** אַדקה, and forsook not the **ordinance** of their God:

They fail in their ambition:

59:9 Therefore is **judgment משפט** far from us, neither doth **justice צדקה** overtake us

59:14 And **judgment צדקה** is turned away backward, and **justice צדקה** standeth afar off

These qualities can only come from God:

9:7 Of the increase of *his* government and peace *there shall be* no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with **judgment** משפט and with **justice** נדקה from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.
