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
64:2 "the melting fire"?

"Melting" = המסים, nowhere else in OT

- KJV: derives from oon "to melt," but missing one letter
- 1QIsa^a עמסים directs attention to Arabic forms with both *h* and ^c meaning "brushwood"

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Why should God cause the Mountains to Flow?

64:1 Oh that thou wouldest rend the heavens,

63:12 to make himself **an everlasting name**

63:14 to make thyself **a glorious name**.

Num 14:15-16 Now *if* thou shalt kill *all* this people as one man, then the nations which have heard **the fame of thee** will speak, saying, 16 Because the LORD was not able to bring this people into the land which he sware unto them, therefore he hath slain them in the wilderness.

When did the Mountains Flow?

64:3 When thou didst terrible things *which* we looked not for, thou camest down, **the mountains flowed down** at thy presence.

Jdg 5:4 LORD, when thou wentest out of Seir, when thou marchedst out of the field of Edom, the earth trembled, and the heavens dropped, the clouds also dropped water. 5 **The mountains melted** from before the LORD, *even* that Sinai from before the LORD God of Israel.

Exo 19:18 And mount Sinai was altogether on a smoke, because the LORD descended upon it in fire: and the smoke thereof ascended as the smoke of a furnace, and **the whole mount quaked greatly**.




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64:5b-7, God's Wrath against his People
