- "God" and "he" are different
- Perception is of God's work

Him that Waiteth for Him

- Moses: Exo 14:13 Fear ye not, **stand still**, and see the salvation of the LORD
- Jehoshaphat: 2Ch 20:17 Ye shall not need to fight in this battle: set yourselves, **stand ye still**, and see the salvation of the LORD with you, O Judah and Jerusalem:
- The Lord to Ahaz: Isa 30:15 For thus saith the Lord GOD, the Holy One of Israel; **In returning and rest** shall ye be saved; in quietness and in confidence shall be your strength: and ye would not.
- David: Psa 40:1 I waited patiently for the LORD; and he inclined unto me, and heard my cry.
- Isaiah: Isa 40:31 But **they that wait upon the LORD** shall renew *their* strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; *and* they shall walk, and not faint.
