

## Jesus before Pilate

<p><b>Jews Outside</b> The Jews accuse; Pilate evades</p>	<p>29 Pilate then went out unto them, and said, What accusation bring ye against this man?</p> <p>30 They answered and said unto him, If he were not a <b>malefactor</b>, we would not have <b>delivered</b> him up unto thee.</p> <p>31 Then said Pilate unto them, <b>Take ye him, and judge him</b> according to your law.</p> <p>The Jews therefore said unto him, It is not lawful for us to put any man to <b>death</b>:</p> <p>32 That the saying of Jesus might be fulfilled, which he spake, signifying what death he should die.</p>	<p>4 Pilate therefore went forth again, and saith unto them, Behold, I bring him forth to you, that ye may know that <b>I find no fault in him</b>. 5 Then came Jesus forth, wearing the crown of thorns, and the purple robe. And <i>Pilate</i> saith unto them, <b>Behold the man!</b></p> <p>6 When the chief priests therefore and officers saw him, they cried out, saying, <b>Crucify him, crucify him</b>.</p> <p>Pilate saith unto them, <b>Take ye him, and crucify him</b>: for <b>I find no fault in him</b>. 7 The Jews answered him, We have a law, and by our law <b>he ought to die</b>, because he made himself <b>the Son of God</b>.</p> <p>8 When Pilate therefore heard that saying, he was the more afraid;</p>
<p><b>Jesus Inside</b> Pilate interrogates: Jesus asserts higher authority</p>	<p>33 Then Pilate entered into the judgment hall again, and called Jesus, and said unto him, <b>Art thou the King of the Jews?</b></p> <p>34 Jesus answered him, Sayest thou this thing of thyself, or did others tell it thee of me?</p> <p>35 Pilate answered, Am I a Jew? Thine own nation and the chief priests have delivered thee unto me: what hast thou done?</p> <p>36 Jesus answered, My <b>kingdom is not of this world</b>: if my <b>kingdom</b> were of this world, then would my servants fight, that I should not be delivered to the Jews: but now is my <b>kingdom</b> not from hence.</p> <p>37 Pilate therefore said unto him, Art thou a <b>king</b> then?</p> <p>Jesus answered, Thou sayest that I am a <b>king</b>. To this end was I born, and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth. Every one that is of the truth heareth my voice.</p> <p>38 Pilate saith unto him, What is truth?</p>	<p>9 And went again into the judgment hall, and saith unto Jesus, <b>Whence art thou?</b></p> <p>But Jesus gave him no answer.</p> <p>10 Then saith Pilate unto him, Speakest thou not unto me? knowest thou not that I have power to crucify thee, and have power to release thee?</p> <p>11 <i>Jesus answered</i>, Thou couldest have no power <i>at all</i> against me, except it were given thee <b>from above</b>: therefore he that delivered me unto thee hath the greater sin.</p> <p>12 And from thenceforth Pilate sought to release him: but the Jews cried out, saying, If thou let this man go, thou art not <b>Caesar's</b> friend: whosoever maketh himself a <b>king</b> speaketh against <b>Caesar</b>.</p>
<p><b>Jews Outside</b> Pilate announces Jesus as King; the Jews prefer an alternative</p>	<p>38 And when he had said this, he went out again unto the Jews, and saith unto them, <b>I find in him no fault at all</b>. 39 But ye have a custom, that I should release unto you one at the passover: will ye therefore that I release unto you the <b>King of the Jews?</b></p> <p>40 Then cried they all again, saying, <b>Not this man, but Barabbas</b>. Now Barabbas was a robber.</p>	<p>13 When Pilate therefore heard that saying, he brought Jesus forth, and sat down in the judgment seat in a place that is called the Pavement, but in the Hebrew, Gabbatha. 14 And it was the preparation of the passover, and about the sixth hour: and he saith unto the Jews, <b>Behold your King!</b></p> <p>15 But they cried out, Away with <i>him</i>, away with <i>him</i>, <b>crucify him</b>.</p> <p>Pilate saith unto them, Shall I crucify your <b>King</b>?</p> <p>The chief priests answered, <b>We have no king but Caesar</b>.</p>
<p><b>Jesus Inside, Away</b> Pilate mistreats Jesus</p>	<p>1 <b>Then</b> Pilate <b>therefore</b> took Jesus, and <b>scourged him</b>. 2 And the soldiers platted a crown of thorns, and put <b>it</b> on his head, and they put on him a purple robe, 3 And said, Hail, <b>King of the Jews!</b> and they smote him with their hands.</p>	<p>16 <b>Then delivered</b> he him <b>therefore</b> unto them to be <b>crucified</b>.</p>
