 9, "Joshua ... went up from Gilgal"

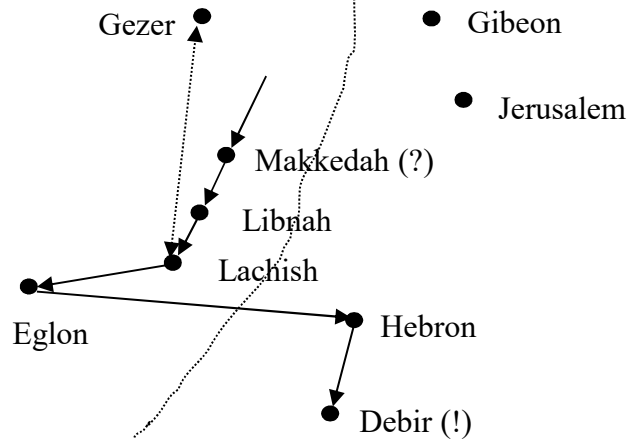
10-43, The Battle

10-15, "The Lord ... smote" (The Long Day)
 11, "they fled"
 15, "Joshua returned ...unto the camp to Gilgal"

16-43, "Joshua smote ..."

16-27, Conquest of the Kings
 16, "the five kings fled"
 16-18, Imprisoned in a cave in Makkedah
 19-20, Completion of the Rout
 21-27, Executed in triumph

28-39, Conquest of the Cities
 28 "Now as for Makkedah..."



40-42, Summary: "All these kings and their land"
