"Filling up" the Gentile Oppression

Rev 13:15 And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed.

Jer 31:15 Thus saith the LORD; A voice was heard in Ramah, lamentation, and bitter weeping; Rahel weeping for her children refused to be comforted for her children, because they were not.

Gen 12:3 And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.

Mat 2:17 Then was fulfilled that which was spoken by Jeremy the prophet, saying, 18 In Rama was there a voice heard, lamentation, and weeping, and great mourning, Rachel weeping *for* her children, and would not be comforted, because they are not.

Gen 37:35 [Jacob] refused to be comforted; and he said, For I will go down into the grave unto my son mourning. Thus his father wept for him. 42:36 And Jacob their father said unto them, Me have ye bereaved of my children: Joseph is not, and Simeon is not, and ye will take Benjamin away: all these things are against me.

Persecution and Tribulation in this Present Evil Age



Joh 16:33 These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.

Persecution in Matthew 10 and 24

Endure:

Luk 21:19 In your patience υπομονη possess ye your souls.

Rev 2:10 (Smyrna) be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.

"unto the end" = "endure completely, stedfastly"

Luk 18:5 Yet because this widow troubleth me, I will avenge her, lest by her **continual** coming she weary me.

Jos 10:20 LXX And it came to pass, when Joshua and the children of Israel had made an end of slaying them with a very great slaughter, **till they were consumed**, that the rest *which* remained of them entered into fenced cities.

"be saved"

Rev 2:10 ... I will give thee a **crown of life**.

Luk 21:19 possess ye your souls ψυχη.

Mat 16:25 For whosoever will **save** his life ψυχη shall lose it: and whosoever will lose his life ψυχη for my sake shall find it. ~ 10:39

Mat 10:28 And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul ψυχη: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.
