
Doubting Believers, 28:17

Mat 14:28 And Peter answered him and said, Lord, if it be thou, bid me come unto thee on the water. 29 And he said, Come. And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus. 30 But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me. 31 And immediately Jesus stretched forth his hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou **doubt**?


Joh 20:14 And when she had thus said, she turned herself back, and saw Jesus standing, and knew not that it was Jesus. 15 Jesus saith unto her, Woman, why weepest thou? whom seekest thou? She, supposing him to be the gardener, saith unto him, Sir, if thou have borne him hence, tell me where thou hast laid him, and I will take him away.

Luk 24:15 And it came to pass, that, while they communed *together* and reasoned, Jesus himself drew near, and went with them. 16 **But their eyes were holden** that they should not know him.



Matt. 13:52 Then said he unto them, Therefore every scribe which is **instructed** unto the kingdom of heaven is like unto a man that is an householder, which bringeth forth out of his treasure things new and old.

Matt. 27:57 When the even was come, there came a rich man of Arimathaea, named Joseph, who also himself was Jesus' disciple [had been discipled to Jesus]:

Acts 14:21 And when they had preached the gospel to that city, and had **taught** many, they returned again to Lystra, and to Iconium, and Antioch,

Luk 14:33 So likewise, whosoever he be of you that forsaketh not all that he hath, he cannot be my disciple.

Mat 10:5 These twelve Jesus sent forth, and commanded them, saying, Go not into the way of the Gentiles, and into any city of the Samaritans enter ye not: 6 But go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.

Mat 15:24 But he answered and said, I am not sent but unto the lost sheep of the house of Israel.

Baptism in the NT

Whom? "All nations [n] ... them [m] ..."

Mat 25:32 before him shall be gathered **all nations [neuter]**: and he shall separate **them [masculine]** one from another, as a shepherd divideth his sheep from the goats:

How?

Acts 2:38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and **be baptized** every one of you **in επι the name of Jesus Christ** for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

Acts 8:16 (For as yet he was fallen upon none of them: only they were **baptized in EIC** the name of the Lord Jesus.)

Acts 10:48 And he commanded them to be **baptized in** the name of the Lord. Then prayed they him to tarry certain days.

Acts 19:5 When they heard this, they were baptized in EIC the name of the Lord Jesus.

Eiς (as in 28:19) לשׁם "with respect to," "in identification with"

Acts 19:3 And he said unto them, **Unto εις** what then were ye baptized? And they said, **Unto εις** John's baptism.

Rom. 6:3 Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into εις Jesus Christ were baptized into εις his death?

1 Cor. 10:2 And were all baptized **unto** EIS Moses in the cloud and in the sea;

Ev, επι בשׁם "with the name"

Prayer "in **EV** the name of Jesus" John 14:13 etc.

Mat 18:5 And whoso shall receive one such little child in επι my name receiveth me.
