Fear of God

Fear of God's Judgment commanded:

Jos. 24:14 Now therefore **fear the Lord**, and **serve him** in sincerity and truth (cf. 1 Sam 12:24)

Act 9:31 Then had the churches rest throughout all Judaea and Galilee and Samaria, and were edified; and walking in the fear of the Lord, and in the comfort of the Holy Ghost, were multiplied.

Ecc 12:13 **Fear God**, and **keep his commandments**: for this *is* the whole *duty* of man. 14 For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether *it be* good, or whether *it be* evil.

Fear of worldly threats forbidden:
