- 1. Who is speaking in each verse of the Psalm?
- 2. What is the relation of v. 2 to v. 1?
- 3. If the *selah* marks the major division, how do vv. 1-2 function in relation to the rest of the Psalm?
- 4. What is the "congregation of the mighty"?
 - a) What is a better translation for "mighty" (see Strong's number)?
 - b) This phrase appears only here in the OT, but the phrase "congregation of Jehovah" (KJV "congregation of the Lord") appears several times. To what does it refer?
 - c) How can the answer to the previous question help you answer the main question?
- 5. Who are the "gods" of vv. 1, 6?
 - a) How does our Lord describe this group in John 10:35?
 - b) In v. 6, God claims to have used this title of these individuals previously. Examine the Strong's numbers in Ex 21:6; 22:8, 9 to see how "gods" is translated in those verses.
 - c) How do vv. 2-4 support this translation?
 - d) Why would God describe human judges as "gods"? What does this tell us about the nature and responsibility of magistrates? What NT passage comments on and expands this insight?
- 6. What is the logical progression among vv. 3-7? Compare the progression in Ps 81:8-12.
- 7. How does v. 8 expand the claim of v. 1?
