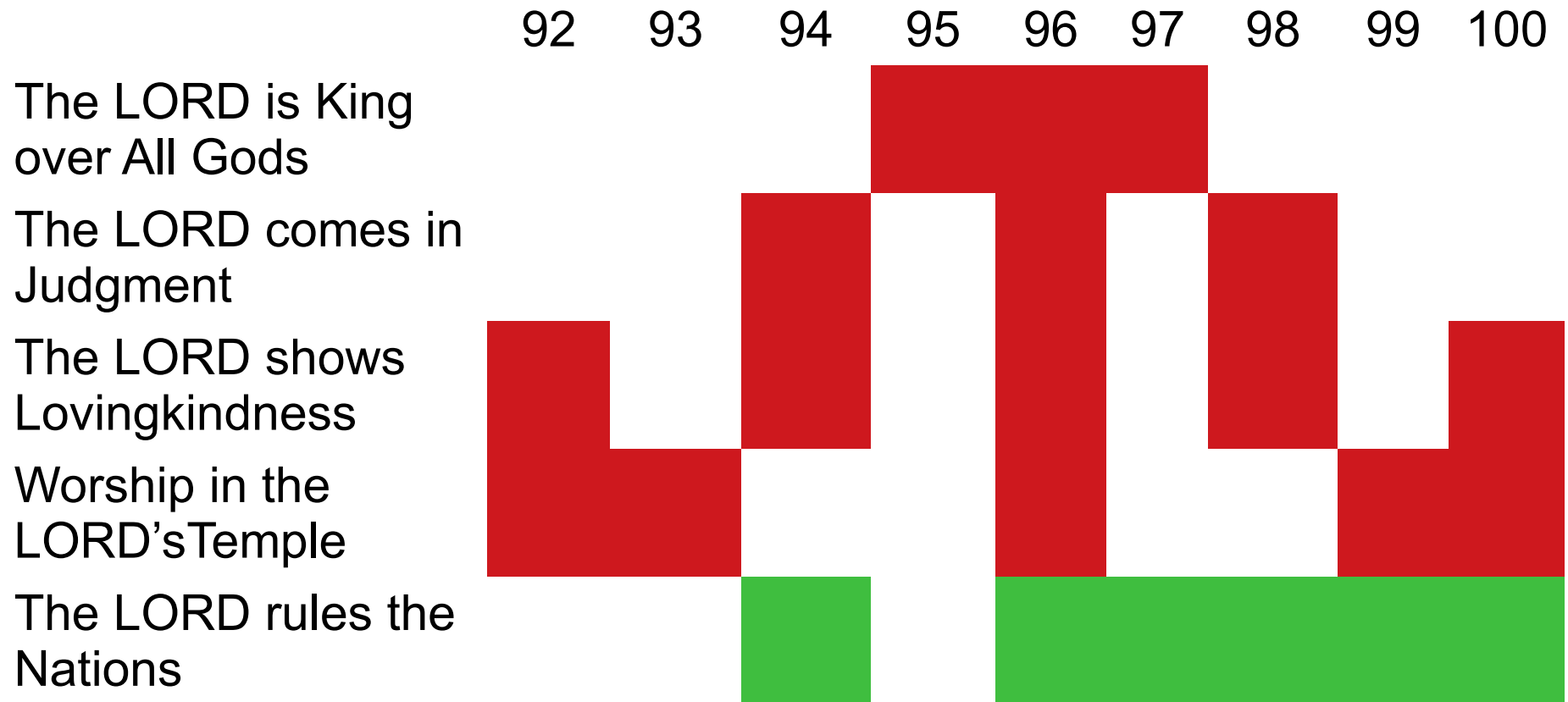

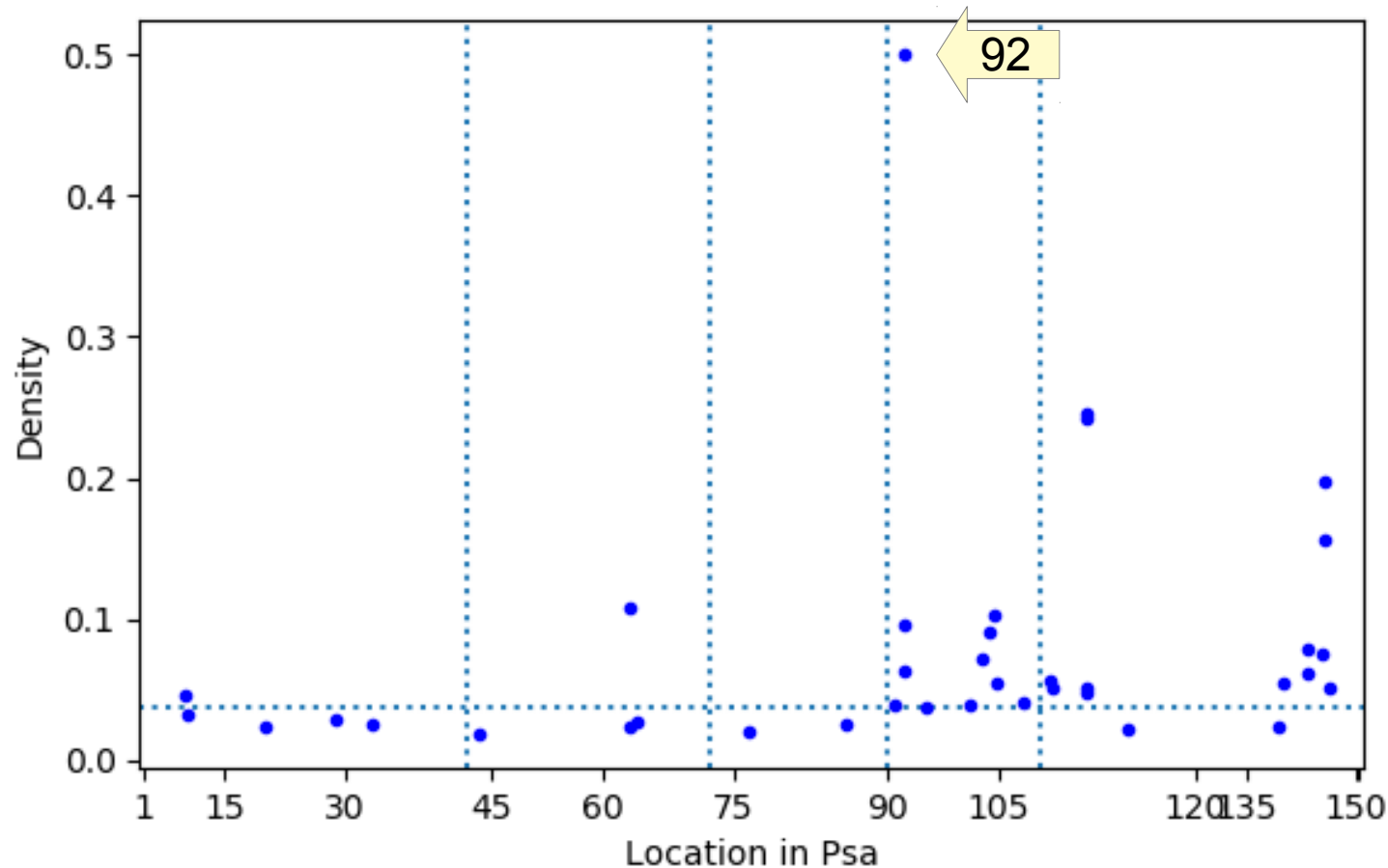

# God's Works (מעשה or פֶּעַל Strong 6467 or מעשה Strong 4639) in Psalms



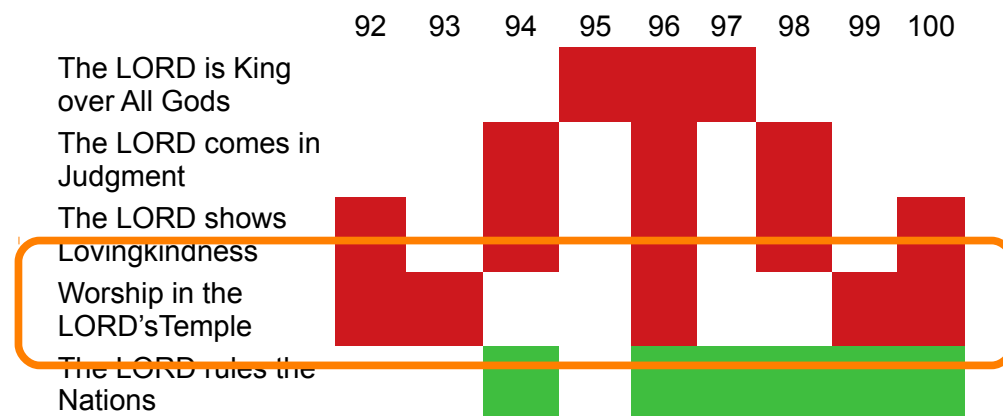

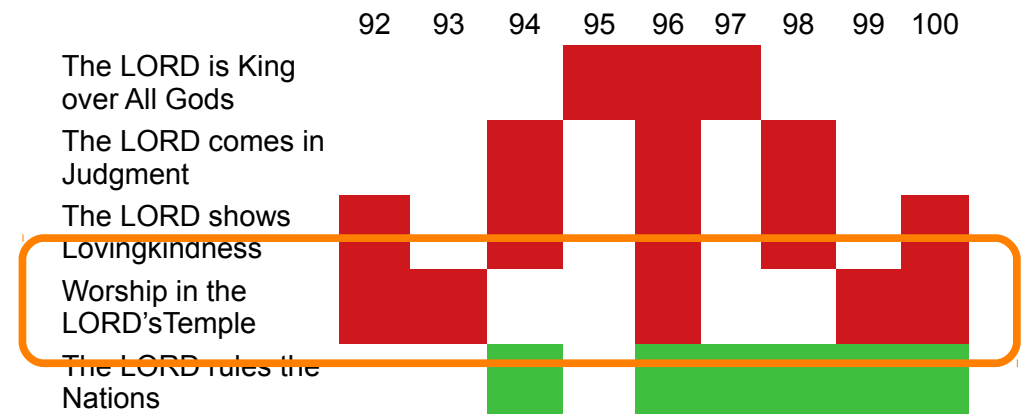
