

## Hebrews 11:8-16

8-10, Abraham (“he”)	13-16, His Innumerable Seed (“they”)
<b>Faith</b>	
8 By faith Abraham ... <b>obeyed</b> when <b>he</b> was called to go out into a place which <b>he</b> should after receive for an inheritance, and <b>he went out</b> , not knowing whither he went.	13 <b>These</b> all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were <b>persuaded of them</b> , and <b>embraced them</b> ,
<b>Forfeit</b>	
9 By faith <b>he sojourned</b> in the land of promise, as <i>in</i> a <b>strange</b> country, dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise:	and confessed that <b>they</b> were <b>strangers</b> and <b>pilgrims</b> on the earth.
<b>Focus</b>	
10 <b>For he looked for a city</b> which hath foundations,	14 <b>For they</b> that say such things declare plainly that <b>they seek a country</b> . 15 And truly, if <b>they</b> had been mindful of that <i>country</i> from whence <b>they</b> came out, <b>they</b> might have had opportunity to have returned. 16 But now <b>they desire a better country</b> , that is, an heavenly:
<b>Foundation</b>	
whose builder and maker <i>is</i> <b>God</b> .	wherefore <b>God</b> is not ashamed to be called <b>their God</b> : for he hath prepared for <b>them</b> a city.
<b>From One to Many</b>	
11 Through faith also Sara herself received strength to conceive seed, and was delivered of a child when she was past age, because she judged him faithful who had promised. 12 Therefore sprang there even of one, and him as good as dead, <i>so many</i> as the stars of the sky in multitude, and as the sand which is by the sea shore innumerable.
