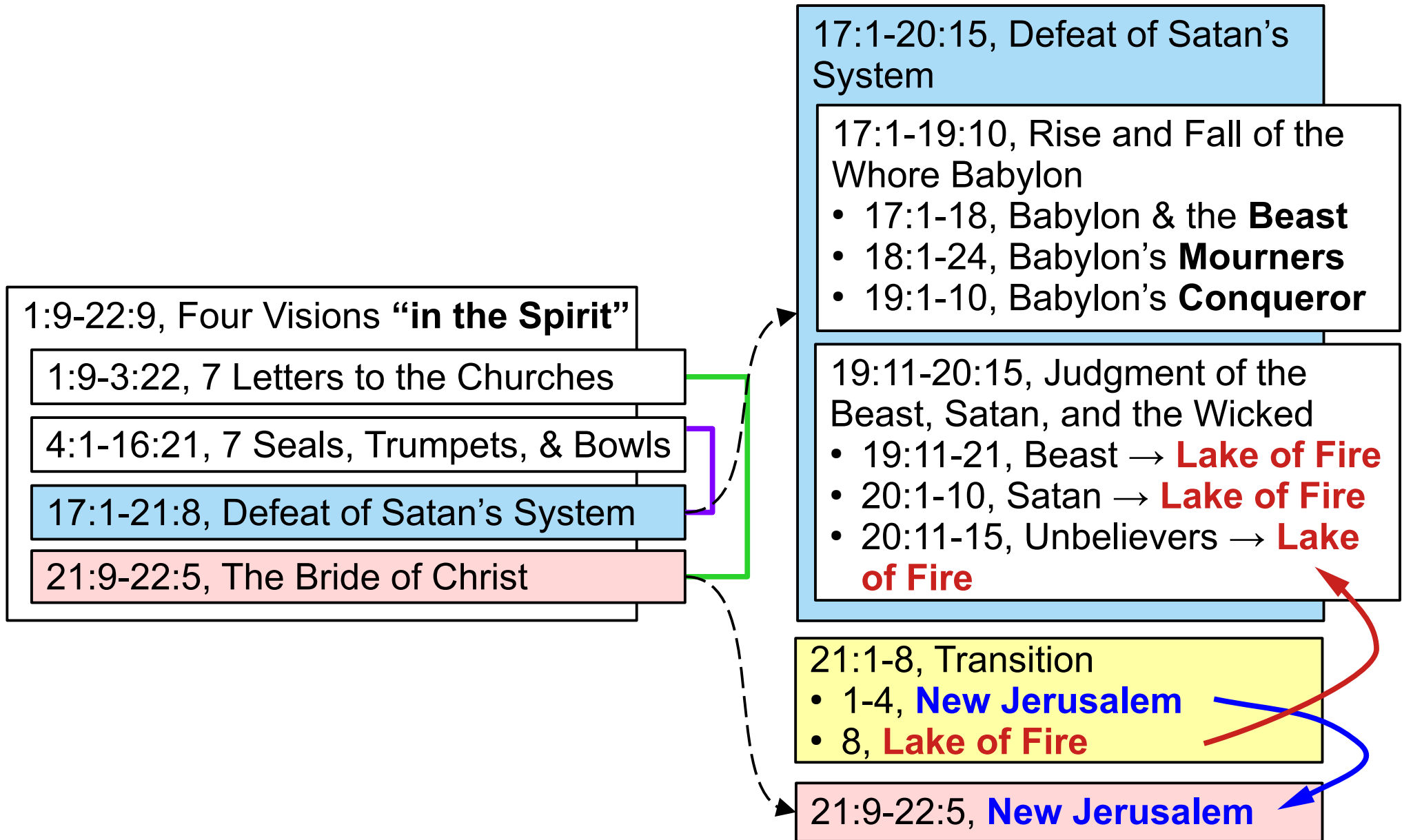
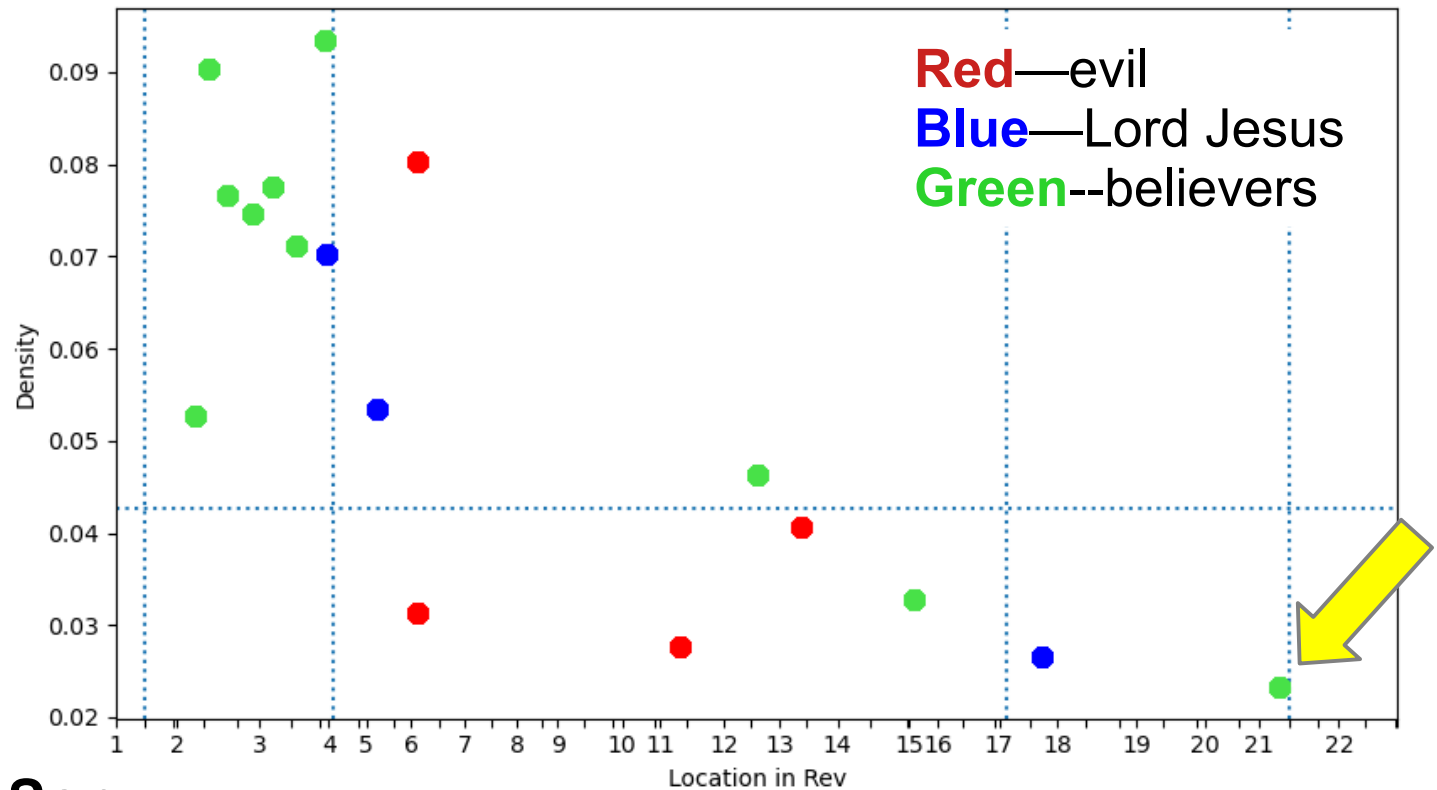


# Transition to the New Jerusalem Rev 21:7-11

## his God ... my Son ...

2Sa 7:12 And when thy days be fulfilled, and thou shalt sleep with thy fathers, I will set up thy seed after thee, which shall proceed out of thy bowels, and I will establish his kingdom. 13 He shall build an house for my name, and I will stablish the throne of his kingdom for ever. 14 I will be his father, and **he shall be my son.**

Rev 3:21 To him that **overcometh** will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also **overcame**, and am set down with my Father in his throne.

# Doomed to the Lake of Fire

## Fearful

2Ki 17:34 Unto this day they do after the former manners: **they fear not the LORD**, neither do they after their statutes, or after their ordinances, or after the law and commandment which the LORD commanded the children of Jacob, whom he named Israel; 35 With whom the LORD had made a covenant, and charged them, saying, **Ye shall not fear other gods**, nor bow yourselves to them, nor serve them, nor sacrifice to them: 36 But the LORD, who brought you up out of the land of Egypt with great power and a stretched out arm, **him shall ye fear**, and him shall ye worship, and to him shall ye do sacrifice. 37 And the statutes, and the ordinances, and the law, and the commandment, which he wrote for you, ye shall observe to do for evermore; and **ye shall not fear other gods**. 38 And the covenant that I have made with you ye shall not forget; **neither shall ye fear other gods**. 39 But **the LORD your God ye shall fear**; and he shall deliver you out of the hand of all your enemies. 40 Howbeit they did not hearken, but they did after their former manner.

## Abominable

Rom 2:22 thou that **abhorrest** idols, dost thou commit sacrilege?

Deut 29:16 And ye have seen their **abominations**, and their idols, wood and stone, silver and gold, which were among them:

Rev 2:14 thou hast there [Pergamos] them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, **to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.**

Rev 2:20 thou [Thyatira] sufferest that woman Jezebel, which calleth herself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce my servants **to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed unto idols.**

<p>... 4 And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet colour, and decked with <b>gold</b> and <b>precious stones</b> and <b>pearls</b>,</p>	<p>and her light was like unto <b>a stone most precious</b>, even like a jasper stone, clear as crystal; ... 18 And the building of the wall of it was of jasper: and the city was pure <b>gold</b>, like unto clear glass. 19 And the foundations of the wall of the city were garnished with all manner of <b>precious stones</b>. ... 21 And the twelve gates were twelve <b>pearls</b>; every several gate was of one pearl: and the street of the city was pure <b>gold</b>, as it were transparent glass.</p>

# References on 21:9-11

## 9 the bride

Rev 21:2 And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

## 10 And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain

Ezk 40:1 In the five and twentieth year of our captivity, in the beginning of the year, in the tenth day of the month, in the fourteenth year after that the city was smitten, in the selfsame day the hand of the LORD was upon me, and **brought me thither**. 2 In the visions of God brought he me into the land of Israel, and set me upon a **very high mountain**, by which was as the frame of a city on the south. 3 And he brought me thither, and, behold, there was a man, whose appearance was like the appearance of brass, with a line of flax in his hand, and **a measuring reed**; and he stood in the gate.

## that great city, the holy Jerusalem

Rev. 3:12 Him that overcometh will I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him the name of my God, and the name of **the city of my God, which is new Jerusalem**, which **cometh down out of heaven** from my God: and I will write upon him my new name.

Rev 11:1 And there was given me a reed like unto a rod: and the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure the temple of God, and the altar, and them that worship therein. 2 But the court which is without the temple leave out, and measure it not; for it is given unto the Gentiles: and **the holy city shall they tread under foot** forty and two months.

Rev 11:8 And their dead bodies shall lie in the street of **the great city**, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also our Lord was crucified.

Rev. 20:9 And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the camp of the saints about, and **the beloved city**: and fire came down from God out of heaven, and devoured them.

# 11 ... having the glory of God ...

1Co 2:7 But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto **our glory**:

2Th 1:9 Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power; 10 When he shall come to be **glorified in his saints**, and to be admired in all them that believe (because our testimony among you was believed) in that day.

Eph 5:25 Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it; 26 That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, 27 That he might present it to himself **a glorious church**, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

Psa 45:13 The king's daughter is all **glorious** within: her clothing is of wrought gold.
