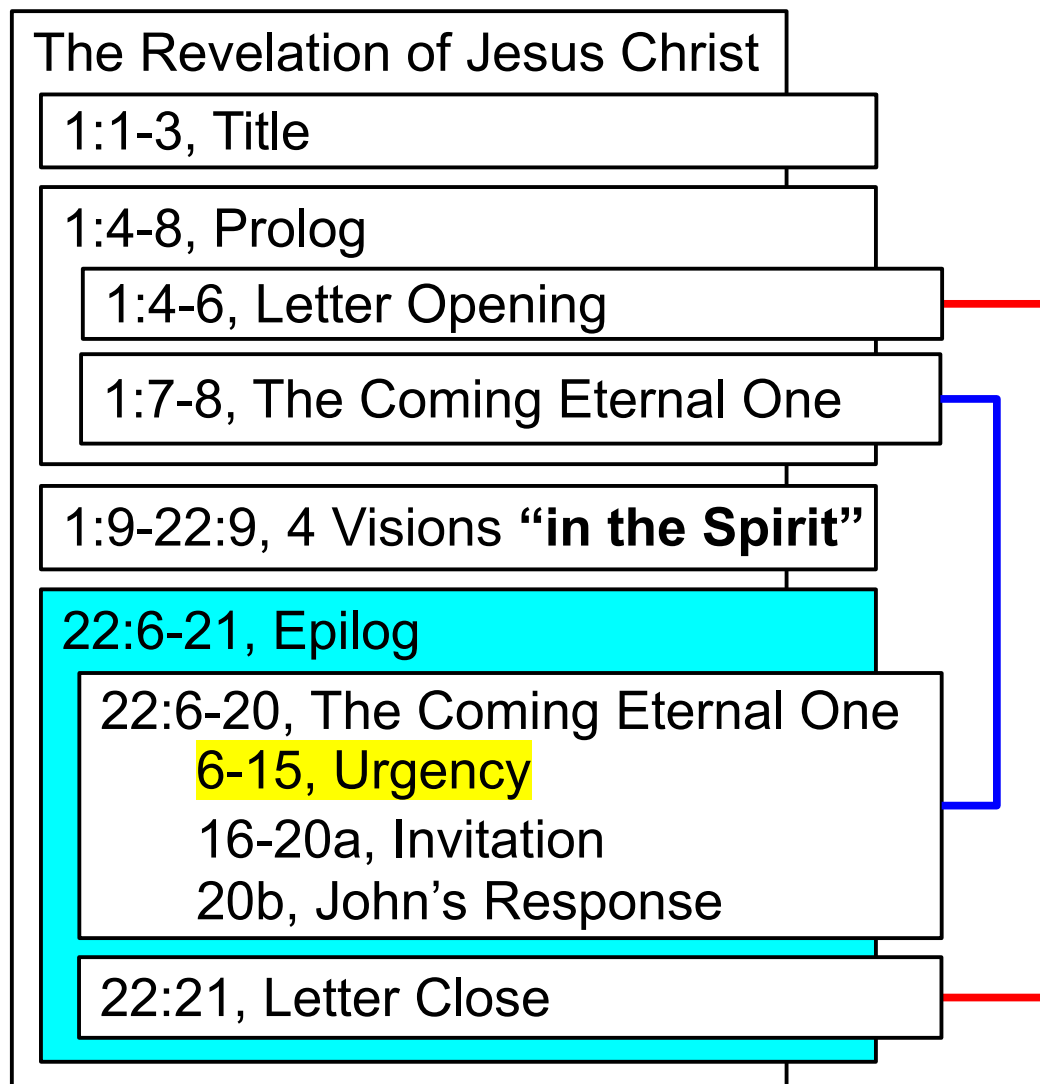


The Epilog



22:6-15, The Urgency of the Situation

22:6 And he said saith unto me, These sayings are faithful and true: and the Lord God of the holy prophets sent his angel to shew unto his servants the things which must shortly be done.	22:10 And he saith unto me, Seal not the sayings of the prophecy of this book: for the time is at hand (1:3). 11 He that is unjust, let him be unjust still: and he which is filthy, let him be filthy still: and he that is righteous, let him be righteous still: and he that is holy, let him be holy still.

6b faithful and true

Rev. 3:14 And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; These things saith the Amen, the **faithful and true** witness, the beginning of the creation of God;

Rev. 19:11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called **Faithful and True**, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.

Rev. 21:5 And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. And he said unto me, Write: for these words are **true and faithful**.

6c sent his angel

Rev 1:1 The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave unto him, to shew unto his servants things which must shortly come to pass; and **he sent and signified it by his angel** unto his servant John:

Rev 22:16 **I Jesus have sent mine angel** to testify unto you these things in the churches.

10 seal not the sayings

Dan 12:4 But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and **seal the book**, even to the time of the end: many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased.

Rev 1:3 Blessed is he that readeth, and they that hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written therein: **for the time is at hand**.

11 ... let him be unjust ...

Dan 12:10 Many shall be purified, and made white, and tried; but **the wicked shall do wickedly**: and none of the wicked shall understand; but **the wise shall understand**.

Ezek 3:27 But when I speak with thee, I will open thy mouth, and thou shalt say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD; **He that heareth, let him hear**; and **he that forbeareth, let him forbear**: for they are a rebellious house.

Daniel: Death of the Messiah

Dan 9:24 Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy. 25 Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince shall be seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times. 26 And after threescore and two weeks **shall Messiah be cut off**, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall **destroy the city and the sanctuary**; and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.

Roadsigns to the Kingdom

Gospels: Worldwide Preaching

Lk 19:11 ... he added and spake a parable, because he was nigh to Jerusalem, and because they thought that the kingdom of God should **immediately appear**.

Mat 24:6 And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all these things must come to pass, but **the end is not yet**. ... 14 And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and **then shall the end come**.

Paul: Widespread Apostasy

2Th 2:1 Now we beseech you, brethren, by the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and by our gathering together unto him, 2 That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand. 3 Let no man deceive you by any means: for **that day shall not come**, except there come **a falling away first**, and that **man of sin be revealed**, the son of perdition; 4 Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, shewing himself that he is God.

The situation when John writes:

Apostasy

Ephesus: Rev 2:4 Nevertheless I have somewhat against thee, because **thou hast left thy first love**. 5 Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent.

Pergamos: Rev 2:14 But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that **hold the doctrine of Balaam**, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication. 15 So hast thou also them that **hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitans**, which thing I hate.

Thyatira: Rev 2:20 Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee, because thou **sufferest that woman Jezebel**, which calleth herself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce my servants to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed unto idols.

Sardis: Rev 3:1 And unto the angel of the church in Sardis write; These things saith he that hath the seven Spirits of God, and the seven stars; I know thy works, that **thou hast a name that thou livest, and art dead**.

Laodicea: Rev 3:16 So then because **thou art lukewarm**, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth.

Appearance of Antichrist

1Jn 2:18 Little children, it is the last time: and as ye have heard that antichrist shall come, **even now are there many antichrists**; whereby we know that it is the last time.

1Jn 4:3 And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and **even now already** is it in the world.
