





## **Timeline of Judges**




#### Ruth 1

Why did Elimelech migrate to Moab?







## Chiasm (ABC-D-C'B'A') in 1:1-6

A: 1:1 Now it came to pass in the days when the judges ruled, that there was a famine in the land.

B: And a certain man of Bethlehemjudah went to sojourn in the country of Moab, he, and his wife, and his two sons.

2 And the name of the man was Elimelech, and the name of his wife Naomi, and the name of his two sons Mahlon and Chilion, Ephrathites of Bethlehemjudah. [external inclusio] And they **came** into the **country of Moab**, and **continued there**.

C: 3 And Elimelech Naomi's husband **died**; and **she was left**, and her two sons.

A': for she had heard in the country of Moab how that the **LORD** had visited his people in giving them bread.

B': 6 Then she **arose** with her daughters in law, that she might return from the country of Moab:

C': 5 And Mahlon and Chilion died also both of them; and the woman was left of her two sons and her husband.

D: 4 And they took them wives of the women of Moab; the name of the one was Orpah, and the name of the other Ruth: and they dwelled there about ten years.
